### Britannia Mine Museum Celebrates 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Historic Mill Building

2023 marks the 100th anniversary of the construction of the iconic Mill Building at the Britannia Mine Museum in Squamish, BC. A National Historic Site of Canada, the mine was once one of the largest copper producers in the British Commonwealth.

Throughout the year, a series of special events will celebrate the role the Mill Building has played, and continues to play, in the community. From May 20-September 4, 2023, a new exhibition will take a closer look at the past mills, the technology and engineering marvels pioneered within the current Mill Building, and the changes it has seen over the past century.

Visitors can also experience [BOOM!](#) – a permanent, live-action, multi-sensory special effects show that brings the historic Mill Building back to life. The 15-minute theatrical spectacle will transport visitors back in time to its working era of the 1920s. The show shares the story of the awe-inspiring, 20-storey Mill Building; one of North America’s last gravity-fed mills.
